7. The School shall abide by the provision of Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education rule. 2011 (Annexure-II).
8. The Society / School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
9. The School shall not deny admission to any child
  - (i) For lack of age proof.
  - (ii) If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period of 90 day for admission.
  - (iii) On the ground of religion, Caste or race, place of birth or any of them
10. The School shall ensure that,
  - (xv) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of Elementary Education in that school.
  - (xvi) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
  - (xvii) No requirement to pass any Board examination till the completion of Elementary Education.

- (xix) Student with disabilities/ special needs are given admission as per provision of the Act,

22. **It may be ensured that teachers appointed in the school are TET qualified.**


