- On Parents request grade PP- III was introduced in session 2024.
- Extra classes for 10<sup>th</sup> class started from 10<sup>th</sup> January 2024.
- Regular school started functioning on 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 for I to X classes.
- On 1st March 2024 regular classes started for Pre-Primary.

### b) <u>Students Strength:</u>

- In the last academic session the school strength was : 167
- New admissions in academic session 2023-24 : 11
- Total strength in the new academic session : 150
- c) <u>Student Enrichment Programme</u>: Headmaster informed that students are participating in various competitions and activities within the school and they are being given desired exposure to excel in various fields.
